Only Full Members of Clubs enjoy reciprocal rights

Members must realize that **reciprocity is a privilege** and as well as introducing yourself before playing a course **should enter the local competition** and have a drink at the club after playing.

CONDITIONS OF PLAYING ON COURSE (Men's Program)

1. Check course Local Rules before starting play.
2. Check event type on top of competition book. Members are to enter competition book with name and competition money and record entry in the Golf link Data Base. If the player(s) are unable to enter the competition at the beginning of play, then they should do so after the first nine holes (or at their earliest convenience).
3. All competition cards are to be placed in the competition box at the completion of the round. Cards not lodged within 15 minutes are subject to disqualification. In line with the new handicap system, players must record their Stableford points on all stroke round cards.
4. Subscriptions are due on April 1st any member who is not financial after April 14th and has not organised an agreement with the treasurer, is ineligible for all pennant and club competitions.
5. Practice will be restricted to the practice paddock and practice putting green only. Practice on the course prior to an event is strictly forbidden (Rule 7.1B).
6. All events to be played off blue or red markers unless otherwise stipulated by Captains committee.
7. **Competition Times for Winter Competitions:** Players may hit off at any time after 7am with the stipulation that later starters must have their cards handed in by 5pm. Once a month on the MEDAL day there will be competitions in grades and the Privilege Cup will be awarded. On this day all players are urged to hit off between 10.00am and 11.00am. The purpose of this is to increase the general fellowship in the club and to give the sponsors for all trophies in the month a presentation that acknowledges their generosity.
8. Competitions will be held for Full Members on all weekend days including days of pennant matches.
 - (a) Eagles during the winter season will receive one dozen golf balls. Eagles during the summer club competitions will receive 6 balls only.
 - (b) Trophies, i.e. balls, not claimed within 3 months will be forfeited. This rule will be strictly adhered to.
9. Please carry a sand bucket and repair divot holes on the fairways and rough, and pitch marks on the greens.
10. The Club Programme may be subject to alteration with Captains-committee's approval.

Additionally, **the following conditions apply to all players**

Any member may ride in mobile carts in any competition at the discretion of the men's or ladies' captain.

Mobile phones must be turned off or on silent when on the golf course and may only be used in a medical emergency. Conditions of Play specific to the Ladies' Program are displayed on the appropriate notice board within the Club House.

CLUB CHAMPIONSHIPS – Men

The Barmera Club Champion will receive the Perpetual Roger Barbour Memorial Barmera Golf Club Cup.

Conditions of Entry:

- a) There are three rounds designated for qualifying. The best two for any player are used as the qualifying rounds.
- b) The top eight gross scores after the two qualifying rounds WILL contest the club championship irrespective of the grade.
- c) After the top eight qualified players for the championship have been identified, then the next eight qualifiers in their respective grades will contest those grade championships.
- d) In the event of a tie for the final spots(s) in all grades, the method of matching cards will take place to determine the winner. This is done on the basis of the best score over the last nine holes, if not, the last 6 holes, the last 3 and finally, the 18th.
- e) Championship finals to be played over 27 holes in B & C grades while the championship will be played over 36 holes.

At the conclusion of the finals, a presentation dinner will be held in the Club House.

The player does not have to nominate a fairway until he is ready to tee off, however, once the ball has been struck on tee off, the fairway cannot be nominated if it hasn't already been selected prior to tee off. 3 of the 4 holes will x2 their Stableford score of the nominated hole. The 4th hole on the card is x3 of the Stableford score. Your playing partner will score your joker card.

Guidelines for RGA Pennants

1. Each club is to enter three teams of five players into the RGA Pennant Competition.
2. Teams must always be selected in exact handicap order (a player on 7.6 must be picked in a team before a player on 7.7). Once the teams have been established in correct order the playing order within the team is determined by the captain.
3. Teams must be written into scorebooks by captains and books exchanged before teams are written up for public viewing.
4. During the minor round the visiting teams are to be accorded the honour when hitting off on the first tee. The honour is then decided by the winner of the previous hole
5. All matches are to be played “off the stick”
6. To be eligible to compete in a pennant match a player must be a bona-fide member of the club he represents. This means he must be eligible to participate in the Club Championship.

Hit off Times

It is recommended that teams begin hitting off at 12 o'clock with A grade hitting off in tee one and B grade hitting off of tee ten. C grade can then be spread across both tees or an agreed alternative. This is a recommendation only and clubs can vary times and orders by agreement.

The home team has the responsibility of returning the team result forms to the Riverland Golf Association by 12 noon on the Tuesday following the match by post, email, fax or hand delivery.

Informal nine-hole summer handicaps will be negotiated

Players must be aware of W.G.S.A.'s Sunsmart Policy in relation to playing outdoors, and particularly in the summer season.

SOME THOUGHTS ON ELIMINATING SLOW PLAY

1. Each player walks directly to or adjacent to his or her ball at all times and waits there for the player farthest from the hole to play their shot.
2. That this time is used to assess his or her own shot.
3. We ask you all to get into the habit of playing this way, and if you see anybody NOT playing this way, this is why you are having a slow round.
4. Not being ready on time. Select club and ball while others are having their shots.
5. Delays on tees or greens while marking the card: always mark the card while awaiting your turn at the tee.
6. Players wait with others on the tee until all have played their shot, then walk to their own ball. Walk directly to your own ball, or level with same, and select club to be used while waiting for others to play their own shots.
7. Unnecessary number of practice swings: it is agreed that all players have their preference in this matter, but practice swings should be limited by discretion.
8. Delays in locating lost balls: if after a reasonable period, it is apparent that you are holding up play, call next group through. (Greater than 5 minutes) ball must be declared lost).
9. On the putting green unnecessary marking of balls and players not continuing to putt out: on reading the green and your ball: study the line of your putt immediately. When it is your turn to putt, try wherever possible to putt right out. Marking the ball is sometimes unnecessary, but not always, and should be avoided.
10. Players not using the time on the green while waiting their turn to assess their own putt: whenever possible a player should have assessed his or her putt for direction and speed while the other players are putting, providing in doing so, no interference is caused to the other players.
11. The flag does not need to be attended at all times as you can now putt with the flag in the hole.
12. Leaving buggies around the green on the wrong side of the tee; always place your buggy adjacent to the approach to the next tee.
